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California Education Code Sections 66750 through 66756, commonly referred to as Senate Bill 1914 (Killea), permits undergraduate students enrolled in any campus of the California Community Colleges, the California State University, or the University of California to enroll without formal admission in a maximum of one course per academic term at a campus of either of the other systems on a space available basis at the discretion of the appropriate campus authorities on both campuses. Enrollment is excluded for Graduate Level courses (including Teacher Education courses at 200 and 300 level) and Remedial courses.

Eligibility Requirements

A student is eligible to participate in the Cross-Enrollment Program if they meet all of the following requirements:

1. Completed at least one term at the Home campus as a matriculated student.
2. Enrolled in a minimum of 6 units/credits in the current term.
3. Earned a cumulative GPA of 2.0 at the Home campus.
4. Paid the appropriate tuition and fees at the Home campus for the current term.
5. Completed appropriate academic preparation as determined by host campus.
6. Has been classified as a California resident for tuition purposes at UCI or has been exempted from nonresident tuition under Regents Policy 3105.

Enrollment Conditions

1. Approval for cross-enrollment is valid for **only the one term specified** and is subject to space availability, deadlines, registration procedures, and priorities at UC Irvine. Students must reapply for each term you wish to cross-enroll.
2. You will have to pay any additional fees required by UCI, including e-tech, lab, materials, departmental, breakage and transcript fees.
3. Enrollment in UCI courses during the Summer Session will be assessed an additional Visitor campus fee. Visit the UCI Summer Session website for fee information (<https://summer.uci.edu/fees/>).
4. Academic advising is available only at your Home campus.
5. Students are urged to secure approval of Home campus Registrar first to ensure course meets Home Campus requirements.
6. Evidence of completion of course prerequisites may be required at the time of enrollment (transcript) by the academic counselor.
7. Financial aid is available only through the Home campus. Students eligible for Veterans, Rehabilitation, Social Security and other Federal, State or County benefits must secure eligibility certification through the Home campus.
8. Students are subject to all UC Irvine administrative procedures and deadlines (<https://www.reg.uci.edu/navigation/calendars.html>)
NOTE: Students must request official drops from the UC Irvine University Registrar's office or risk having an unsatisfactory grade recorded on your transcript.
9. Starting Fall 2025 Quarter, permanent records are maintained by the University Registrar (reg.uci.edu). Students needing transcripts for cross-enrollment courses taken prior to Fall 2025 must request those academic records at the Student Services Office at the UC Irvine Division of Continuing Education. (Official transcripts - <https://ce.uci.edu/resources/academic/transcripts/>.)
10. Health services at Host campus (UC Irvine) are limited to treatment of emergencies.
11. Because of overlapping academic calendars, cross-enrollment is possible only in certain combinations:
